Risk Management/Kidsafe Program

POLICY STATEMENT

1. It is the intent of US Youth Soccer and the Ohio South Youth Soccer Association, OSYSA, to deny any person who has been convicted of a crime of violence, or of a crime against a person, or a felony involving the welfare of a child, the opportunity to coach and/or be in contact with youth soccer players and/or youth soccer referees.
2. In applying for a position with OSYSA or any of its member leagues, the information that is furnished on the OSYSA Employment / Volunteer Disclosure form is subject to verification, including conducting a criminal history check.
3. To verify the information provided on the OSYSA Employment / Volunteer form, OSYSA may use the services of a third party provider as provided by law or may require the submission of fingerprints through the State of Ohio Attorney General's office.
4. Any information gathered through the use of the Employment / Volunteer disclosure form, including but not limited to name, date of birth, social security number, residence, driver's license number, will only be used for the designated purposes and objectives of the OSYSA Risk Management program. All such information that is gathered shall be held in confidence and will not be shared, distributed, or provided in any manner, to any person or organization except as noted in # 3 above.
